BIBLE DOCTRINE
SOUL WINNING

Objects to have: A fishing pole, A net like a fisherman's net, some paper fish. A magnet and a paper clip. Put the magnet at the end of the fishing line. Place the paper clip on the mouth of the fish. A New Testament and two volunteers, a pen and a church tract.

Introduction of the lesson: {Take out the fishing pole. Now pretend that you are fishing.} What am I doing? I am fishing. Fishing is a good clean sport. When you catch a fish you can cook them and eat them. This is a fishing rod or a fishing pole. If you are going fishing you would need one of these. On this fishing pole there is fishing line. At the end of the fishing line there is a hook. That is the part that catches the fish. All the parts we just learned about are important to have to be a good fisherman. The fisherman casts his line out into the water and after a while he will catch a fish. {Cast your line someplace where the fish is at. Pull the line back after a few moments, and show them the fish you caught.} Act very excited. I caught a fish! I caught a fish!

It is real exciting when you catch a fish. When you use a fishing rod you can only catch one fish at a time. There is a way to catch more than one fish at a time. To do that you use a net, a fishing net. {Show your fishing net.} This is a fishing net. You throw this net into the water. It sinks deep into the water. After a while you pull it back up and you can catch a group of fish all at one time.

I like to fish. It is fun to fish. Has anyone here fished before? It is good to fish.

Did you know that Jesus wants you and me to be fishermen. Yes, that is right. We are to fish for men. {Have your two helpers come in. One should have their New Testament out telling the other one how to be saved.} Look at what is going on. Do you see what is happening. This person is fishing for men. It is called SOUL WINNING.

Jesus wants you and me to be soul winners. That means we go fishing in the world for the souls of boys, girls, men and women. We tell them how to go to heaven so they will never have to go to hell. It is called SOUL WINNING. What is it called? Right, SOUL WINNING. I want to be a soul winner for Jesus.

There are some things we need for soul winning as we need for fishing. We need a New Testament, some tracts, a pen and the leading of the Holy Spirit.

We use the New Testament to give people the Word of God. We use a tract to invite them to church and to let them know where we are from. We use a pen to write down the names of people we win to Christ so we can pray for them. We ask the Holy Spirit to lead us to people who need to be saved and will listen to us as we give the Gospel.

What are the things we need to be soul winners for Jesus? A New Testament, a church tract, a pen and the Holy Spirit. Just as it is important to have all your fishing equipment it is important to have all your soul winning fishing gear.

On Sunday morning after Jesus had been dead for three days. Something started to happen in that tomb. Jesus started to move. Wait, he was dead. How could he move? I don't know maybe his big toe moved first. Maybe it was his finger that moved first. I don't know. All I know is Jesus was dead. Now, he was alive. He wiggled some and started to unwrap himself. Remember he was wrapped up in the sheet. I can see in my mind as he shakes his head and the napkin falls off his face. After a few moments Jesus was standing on his feet. He took those grave cloths and folded them up. He put them in a neat stack in that tomb. Then he walked over to the door of the tomb. At the door was that great big stone. It was sealed so no one could get in or out.
