Butch had heard the heated discussion and had come to investigate. The moment he saw me he ran as fast as he could down the hall and grabbed me around the legs, nearly knocking me down. Well, finally the guard gave in and allowed me to enter the ward. He escorted Butch and me to a conference room where we could talk. I asked Butch why he had been placed in the hospital. He just bowed his head and said, "I don't know." "I don't buy that," I replied. He looked up at me with those deep blue eyes as if to search my soul. As he stared at me, I tenderly said, "I love you, Butch." He quickly answered, "I

love you, too, Preacher." A moment later he told me the terrible story of an abusive father and how he tried to kill him by setting his bed on fire while he slept. I counseled with him, we prayed together, and I left.
